Acceptable Items for Recycling

Where Should it Go?

#1 & #2 Plastic Food & Beverage Containers

Rinse the container.

You may leave any labels on.

Remove the lids & rings, put in trash.

Empty plastics that contained motor oil or hazardous kinds of oil must be clean, dry, and then go in the trash.

Clear Glass Food Containers

Rinse clean -Leave labels on Lids, rings, and broken glass go in the trash.

Paper Products

Newspapers & items with the newspapers, magazines, catalogs, phone books, and junk mail should be put into a clean plastic grocery type bag/sack.

Put soiled paper in the trash.

Tin Cans

Rinse clean and remove labels. *Toss any loose lids into the trash.*

Corrugated Cardboard and Paperboard

Must be clean and flattened.

Wax coated, soiled cardboard or paperboard put in the trash—ex. Pizza boxes.
